

Uganda - decades of hardship and poverty

“The 20 year old Lord’s Resistance Army (LRA) armed rebellion coupled with cattle rustling has brought an untold suffering to people of northern Uganda. Besides escalating poverty, there is total collapse of the basic social infrastructure and services. Many schools and hospitals are non-functional and the very few which are still operational cannot adequately and efficiently meet the populace demand. As a consequence, there has been progressive increase in the number of children dropping out of school and poor health among the population. Over these years, the region has relied on assistance from some humanitarian non-governmental organizations (NGO) operating in the area that have somewhat helped to improve their living conditions. However, the assistance is often not adequate due to the vastness of the region.”
